Survey Questions

Different countries have tried to apply Karl Marx's ideas. These questions inquire about trauma experienced in a Marxism-inspired milieu <u>that is believed to have originated from the ideology of Marxism</u>. Trauma is understood here as emotional, physical, or psychological wounds or upsets. The survey is part of a research project for a book *Who Had a Marxist Experience?* by Erickson and Klein (tmerickson.com).

What inspired the questions?

- 1) As examples, well known leaders like Lenin, Stalin, Mao, and Nyerere, did not possess the *consciousness* Marx admired for industrial, capital creation, activities and, thus, were not qualified to govern States using Marx's ideas.
- 2) Even Mao acknowledged that not everyone believed in collectivizing labor.
- 3) Marx created conceptual chaos about capital and believed capital evolved and that 'money' was the perfected form of capital. Capital is not solely money and Stalin is an example of a leader who demonstrated he inherited this conceptual error of Marx's.
